#### Recipe of the Month:

## Impossibly Easy Chicken and Broccoli Pie

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 cups Frozen Broccoli Cuts, thawed, drained
- 1 1/2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese (6 oz)
- 1 cup cut-up cooked chicken or 2 cans (5 oz each) chunk chicken, well drained
- 1 medium onion, chopped (1/2 cup)
- 1/2 cup Original Bisquick<sup>TM</sup> mix
