

Fox and wild dog bounty

Foxes and wild dogs are established pest animals in Victoria. They cannot be eradicated from the state and require ongoing management by all public and private land owners.

Effective fox and wild dogs management requires an integrated approach utilising all available management practices including



poison baiting, trapping, exclusion fencing, fumigation and appropriate animal husbandry. Hunting can play an important role in supporting an integrated management approach.

This program rewards eligible Victorian hunters with a \$10 bounty reward for each fox killed, and \$120 bounty for each wild dog killed, subject to the <u>Victorian Fox and Wild Dog Bounty Terms and Conditions</u>.
