PROJECT UPDATE 11

Building Healthy & Resilient Communities through Service Equity



About the project

Since February 2022 we've been letting you know about activities and funding received for this project which is now focussed on delivering Stage 2 - delivery of Service Hubs across the district. Funding for Stage 3 - to employ a community nurse/care coordinator is being actively sought. If you need more information you can refer to past updates or get in contact: hello@warmcomersco.com

Call for new volunteers for the Project Reference Group (PRG):

The PRG is calling for anyone interested in being involved to get in touch - open to all levels of experience.

- Membership is voluntary. Meetings are held monthly (4th week of the month) online. An in-person meeting option occurs every second month at Bonang Hall. If you are interested, we can provide the meeting schedule, background information and the terms of reference for all group members.
- You will need to attending meetings, read the monthly project managers report and work collaboratively to make decisions about the project. Sometimes other phone and email contact is needed in-between meetings. Expect to contribute up to 10 hours a month of your time.
- Your initial commitment will be 6 months, with the option to continue or not at the next call for members (October 2023).
- You should consider joining if you are care about the delivery of local services in the area, including health services, and want to be involved in shaping how services are provided and accessed.

Stage 2 – Creation of the Service Hub network: Bonang builder Neil Ingram (Duz-us Alternatives & Constructions) has been appointed to carry out building works to create private consulting rooms at Tubbut Neighbourhood House, Goongerah Hall (Within cowoking space) and Bendoc Neighbourhood House. Higher-speed internet is being connected by Telstra and funded by ConnectWell. Once completed, residents will have a place to meet health workers and other service providers face-to-face, or via video conference. Bonang Hall is receiving a laundry and shower upgrade to the public bathrooms, plans will be available for viewing from 11.30am 6 April 2023 as part of the "Our Future: building Possibilities" event.

Stage 3 - Nurse-led Health Service: Funding is pending for a health-service model delivered in partnership with Orbest Regional Health that would employ a part-time Community Nurse/Care Coordinator for an initial 18-24month contract. If successful, the PRG members will play a key part in determining and overseeing the operating hours, services and model of care.

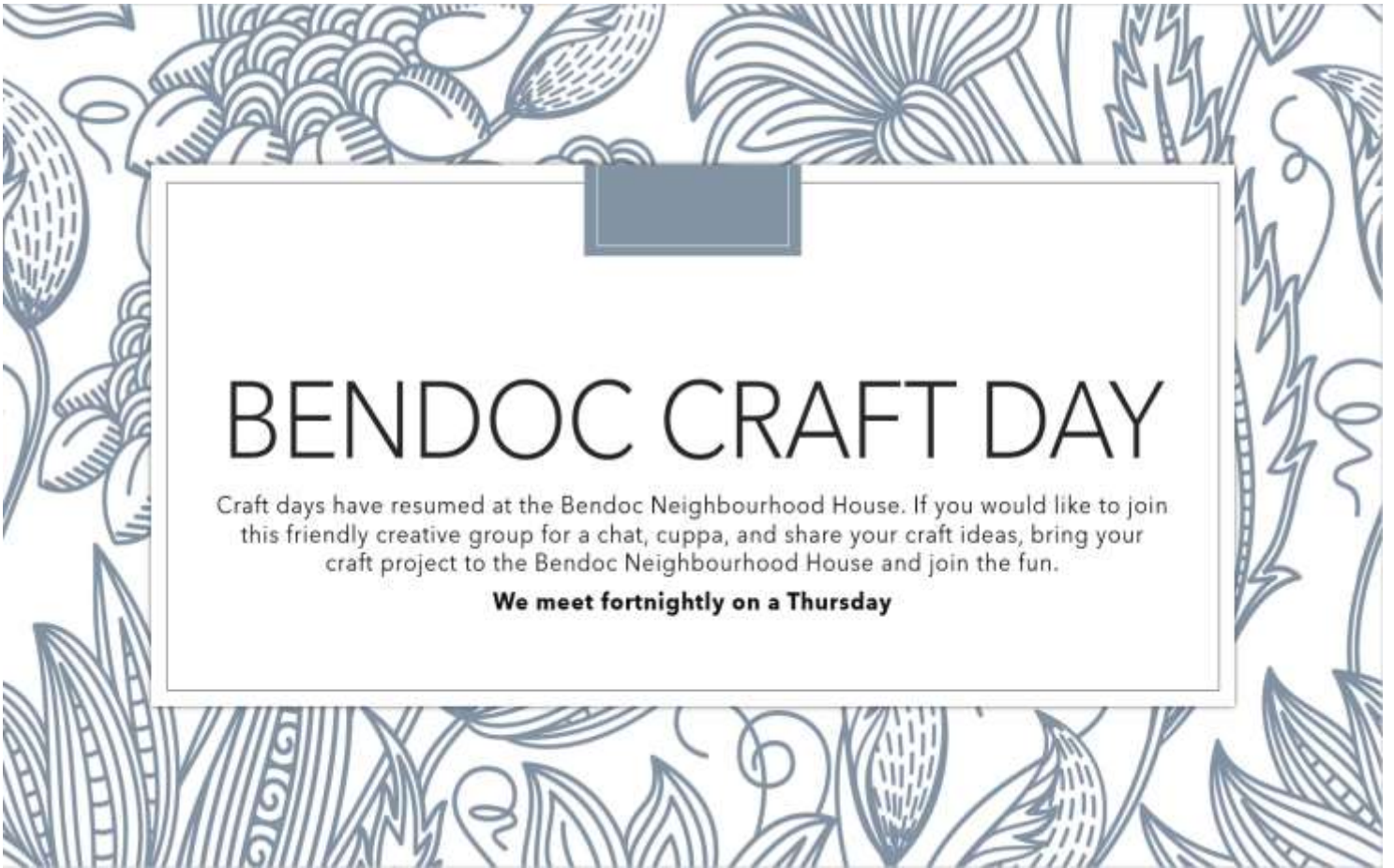
