Free vehicle registration for Victorian apprentices

The Victorian Government has announced vehicle registration will be free for eligible apprentices from July 1, 2023.

Apprentices eligible for free vehicle registration will save up to \$865 every year if their employer can verify that their vehicle is an essential part of their work.

Eligible apprentices can apply for the free vehicle registration via the my VicRoads portal on the Business Connect | June Edition (mailchi.mp).

Timber Innovation Grants Program closes 30 June 2023

This program aims to assist businesses directly affected by the Victorian Forestry Plan to adapt, explore and investigate alternative sources of timber or manufacturing opportunities. It is intended to support Victorian forestry businesses:

- Explore opportunities to process or manufacture using plantation timber feedstock.
- Develop new products using plantation timber.
- Explore processing, harvest and haulage of alternative fibre.
- Investigate downstream manufacturing opportunities using alternative fibre.

Grants of up to \$100,000 are available, applications close 30th June 2023.
