Fire Danger Period Declared

The Fire Danger Period will begin at 1.00am on Monday 9th October, 2023 across the East Gippsland Shire Council municipality.

Ian Cole, the local Mount Delegate CFA Group officer, said “vegetation has dried out considerably over the last few weeks and early indicators were pointing to a long and challenging fire season ahead”.

“It’s still not too late to clean up your property if you haven’t already done so, but the window for burning off has closed,” he said.

“Residents should take up the green waste service offered by their local councils, at the Bonang and Bendoc tips, when preparing their properties through clearing, mowing or slashing,” he said.

During the Fire Danger Period, all fires in the open air are banned without a permit, along with most activities with the potential to generate sparks, and he emphasised that CFA will be taking a zero tolerance approach to any fires resulting from people flouting the laws.

“Expect that any fire you start to be fully investigated by police,” Mr Cole said.

“While CFA does everything it can, we look to the community to use common sense and take responsibility for preventing fires,” he said.

During the Fire Danger Period (FDP) fires cannot be lit in the open air without a written permit from CFA or a Municipal Fire Prevention Officer. The FDP is based on local conditions and takes into account fuel moisture, fuel loads, grassland curing, weather and rainfall.
